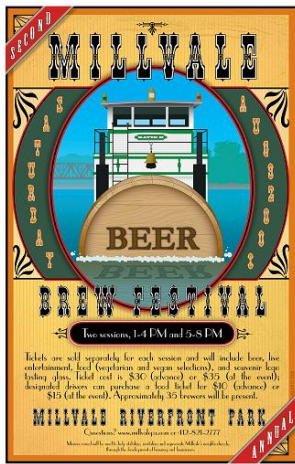
A BREIF AND INTOXICATING HISTORY OF THE MILLVALE BREW FEST

Ever want more from an I.P.A.? Does your go-to Porter lack the bite you are dreaming for? Well, Beaver Brewing can satisfy your needs with our Hybrid beer...the I.Porter.A. It has all of the body you are looking for in a Porter, but the hop flavor you crave in an I.P.A. Ingredients: 2-Row Malt, Pale Malt, Cascade, Fuggle, Columbus, and Cascade Hops. 5% ABV

Basil

Think of a smooth Amber Ale with a hint of Basil in the background... delicious. That's exactly what we did with Basil. The deep amber color is a beer drinkers "wet dream". Just enough hops to add to the flavor but not too many to overpower that Earthy Basil aroma. 5.2% ABV

Saison De Beaver

Saison translates to "Season" in English. Farmers across Europe would make Farmhouse Ales for the summer months for a few reasons...

Most importantly it was a "big" beer. They added "extreme" amounts of hops and malt to have a beer that wouldn't spoil in the hot summer months. The hops were usually very low in Alpha Acid content so the beer was not overly bitter. It was considered a strong beer for the time even though it topped out at 4% ABV.

Absolution Ale

Our Absolution Ale is an American Amber Ale in style. This is a style that has evolved in the last 12 years with the explosion of the microbrewery movement. Ours was brewed with American Grains, American hops, and by American brewers. It is a reasonably big beer with a full profile. This means that it has a big body and a good balance of the malt and hops with neither overpowering the other. The body of the Absolution Ale is full with nice caramel tones, and should finish a touch sweet. The hop character is most noticeable as a hop flavor although it will have some hop bitterness in the finish. Let me know how you like it. ABV: 5.8%

Oktoberfest

The brewers of Bavaria, Germany, typically brewed a special beer for the annual Oktoberfest celebration. The style which evolved for such an occasion is appropriately called an Oktoberfest. You might also hear this beer referred to as a Märzen. That's because this beer was traditionally brewed in March ('Marz' in German) and lagered in caves until September. Because we now enjoy the convenience of refrigeration, we can lager the beer in a much shorter amount of time. Our

Oktoberfest is a light amber colored beer. It is malty in both flavor and aroma making it a delicate beer which is very drinkable. The hop bitterness is kept low to accentuate the maltiness. ABV: 5.2%

DOGFISH HEAD CRAFT BREWED ALES

Milton, DE

60 Minute IPA

Our 60 Minute IPA is continuously hopped - more than 60 hop additions over a 60 minute boil (getting a vibe yet of where the name came from?). 60 Minute is a session India Pale Ale brewed with a slew of great NorthWest hops. 6.0 ABV

Raison D'Étre

A deep, mahogany Belgian-style brown ale brewed with beet sugar, raisins, and Belgian-style yeast. 8.0% ABV

Duquesne Pilsener

Duquesne Pilsener is a straw yellow pilsener made with two-row barley that provides a very gentle bite and is brewed with extra malt for a bright white head. It possesses a clean aroma that is slightly hoppy and balanced with mild maltiness. The use of premium two-row malt gives Duquesne Pilsener more body than the typical American brew. 5% ABV

Fat Gary Nut Brown Ale

This Southern English Brown Ale is brewed with Crystal Malt, Chocolate Malt, some Wheat and Nugget hops. 3.7% ABV

Monkey Boy Hefeweizen

Swinging from tank to tank around here, we've come up with the perfect way to enjoy a bright sparkling taste of summer, no matter what the season may be. This fresh local hefeweizen carries a distinct banana ester profile, and crisp finish. No bananas were harmed or peeled in the brewing of this beer. It's just a little side benefit that our German yeast strain likes give us.

Pedal Pale Ale

An American Pale Ale, crisp and hoppy with light malt sweetness and fruity esters. Hopped four times with just one variety, look for it around town with the most unique, salvaged-bike-parts tap handle you've ever seen. 4.6% ABV

Honey-heather Scottish Ale

Honey Heather Ale: A session ale brewed with honey and heather. 4.4% abv. Honey flavor imparted with grambrinus honey malt at 20% of the grist as well as 10 pounds of super-local 'burgh bees' honey added late in the boil. Heather tips added late in the boil as well as in the secondary. Lightly hopped. A nice brew to finish off the summer with.

We hit this full bodied IPA with "nookie" four times during the brewing process to give this ale its trademark Chinook hop character. We then "dry nookied" this flavorful ale to further enhance its grapefruit and pine aroma. IBU 103.1 ABV 6.2%

White Lightning (Belgian White)

This Belgian White Ale combines a complex malt character with sweet orange peel, coriander and a secret spice. Challenge your taste buds and see if you can guess our secret spice. The end result is a crisp refreshing wheat beer that can be enjoyed all year long. IBU 18 ABV 5.5%

Seneca Indian Pale Ale

Summer Ale

Summer Wheat Ale is a highly drinkable, light bodied ale. The use of wheat and careful hopping produce a beer with a flavor that is slightly tart, with a citrus-like finish. Available May to September. 6% ABV

Black IPA

The Alpine Black IPA made its debut at the Vermont Brewers Festival in Burlington, Vermont in July. It was intended to be a one-off pilot batch and quickly evolved into an instant favorite. To appease demand we have decided to release it as our new Otter Creek Winter Seasonal. Those who attended the VBF were lucky to get a sneak tasting of this incredible brew. Since then it has been the buzz

around town. Allegheny Pale Ale

Brewed with 2 row caramel and euro-pils malts to create a rich amber color and medium body. Chinook hops from the Pacific Northwest provide fragrant hop aroma and are balanced with Columbus and German Perle hops in the finish to create a flavor that is unique to Allegheny Pale Ale. 5.6% ABV

Kaiser Pils

A German-style Pils with pale gold color and good body, this crisp, clean and very bitter beer has pronounced hop aroma and is made with the famous Hallertau hops. Kaiser Pils is brewed with triple decoction mashing. A beer worthy of an Emperor. 4% ABV

Penn Dark

Just possibly the best Munich-style dark beer made in the world today. Surprisingly smooth with a slightly burnt flavor from the black malt, well balanced bitterness and hop aroma. 5% ABV

Penn Oktoberfest

A rich, deep golden-colored lager fest bier that is exceptionally smooth and mellow. Uses two-row malted barley and a combination of roasted malts. Highly rated by the National Tasting Institute. 4.5% ABV

Penn Pilsner

An amber Vienna-style lager beer, smooth, mellow, full-bodied. Uses Two-Row barley malt, caramel-roasted malt, and imported Hallertau Perle and Tradition hops. 5.2% ABV

Penn Weizen

This authentic wheat beer, brewed in the Southern German tradition. Penn Weizen is top-fermented, cask- or bottle- conditioned, and very effervescent with pronounced banana-clove aroma. 5% ABV

Summer Berry Weiss

A light-tasting, wheat beer flavored with a ripe berry blend, perfect for the warm weather season!

Old Jail Ale

A beer for every occasion, with aromas of roasted caramel and toasted marshmallow hitting the nose from the three hand selected European barleys that carefully intertwine to create a bouquet of toasted caramel goodness. A light sprinkling of smooth traditional English and American Hops give the beer some real character and a pleasant floral fragrance. The light finish comes from the soft water we use from our local water supply which is untreated and unfiltered by the brewery. This beer was inspired by Chambersburg's 1818 "Old Jail" that is one of the few structures to have survived the burning of Chambersburg by Confederate Forces in 1864. ABV: 4.3%

Best Blonde

A beer true to its roots. This ale is brewed with all German ingredients and is similar in style to the great Kolsch beers of Cologne, Germany. This ale boasts a generous portion of pale malt blended with light wheat and crystal malt providing a crackery and wheaty aroma and taste. The ale is fermented at cooler temperatures with yeast that delivers a winery and slight fruitiness to the beer. The sweetness of the brew is harnessed by the slight dryness of Noble German Hops as well as the colder fermentation temperatures. The soft water used is similar to the water in Cologne, Germany and provides a perfect background and finish to the beer. The late addition in the kettle of lemon peel enhances the fruitiness and compliments esters from fermentation. Light in body but not in palate, this ale is clean, crisp, and delicious! ABV: 4%

SIX POINT CRAFT ALES

Brooklyn, NY

Bengali Tiger

Sixpoint Bengali Tiger is reminiscent of the century-old English IPA. In my perspective, many current IPAs suffer from lacking substance; unbalanced by a hoppy assertiveness that is not substantiated by a strong foundation of rich malt flavors. Our interpretation uses the highest-quality, floor-malted base malt, which lends a full-bodied and rich caramel flavor. We mash at high temperatures and add generous amounts of specialty malts to further emphasize a strong foundation of malt as leverage for our generous additions of hops... Which are indeed generous. We use a total of three different hop strains, and add a total of six different additions throughout the process. The Bengali Tiger has a hoppy snap upfront, but strides at a steady pace, and finishes balanced. The signature characteristic of the Tiger is the aroma... we use massive quantities of whole East Kent Goldings hops to dry hop in our conditioning tanks. 6.40% ABV

Righteous Ale

Righteous Ale is actually a Rye Beer, brewed with a high amount of hops. 7.40% ABV

Finestkind IPA

The citrusy hop flavor coming from a mixture of Simcoe and Santiams is pleasantly balanced by a smooth bitterness from the Amarillo hops. The beer itself is light bodied and crisp with a golden color that will throw a slight haze, as we bottle it unfiltered. At 65 IBU's, this is definitely not a training-wheels IPA, but is meant for hop lovers looking to satisfy their craving in a way that's not easy to find. We think they'll be quite pleased. *ABV 6.9%*

Old Brown Dog Ale

Old Brown Dog has been cited as a classic example of the "American Brown Ale" style of beer. Compared to a typical English Brown Ale, Old Brown Dog is fuller-bodied and more strongly hopped. 6.5% ABV

Robust Porter

This hearty, mahogany colored ale is brewed to evoke the dark, full-bodied ales that were a favorite of dockworkers and warehousemen (hence the name "Porter") in 19th century London. It is a good bet that when Dickens' Mr. Pickwick sat down for a pint, we would have been drinking an ale much like our Robust Porter. This is a smooth and very drinkable beer,

characterized by its well-balanced malt and hops, plus subtle notes of coffee and chocolate.
ABV 5.7%

Shoals Pale Ale

Our interpretation of a classic English beer style is copper-colored, medium-bodied and highly hopped. Its flavor is delightfully complex: tangy fruit at the start, with assertive hop crispness and a long malty palate that one well-known beer writer has compared to the flavor of freshly-baked bread. *ABV 5.4%*

Summer Weizen

Light, tasty & full of character, our summer wheat ale is brewed with a combination of domestic and continental wheat and barley malts, lightly hopped & fermented with a Belgian wit yeast, resulting in a delightfully tangy & refreshing flavor. 5.8 % ABV

Stone Arrogant Bastard Ale

At Stone Brewing, we believe that pandering to the lowest common denominator represents the height of tyranny - a virtual form of keeping the consumer barefoot and stupid. Blonde Ale

More or less a creation from the craft-brewery movement, and also reminiscent of the German style Kölsch. Pale straw to deep gold for color. Usually an all malt brew, well attenuated with a lightly malty palate. Most have a subdued fruitiness. Hop character is of the noble variety, or similar, leaving a light to medium bitterness. A balanced beer, light bodied and sometimes lager like.

American Stout

Inspired from English & Irish Stouts, the American Stout is the ingenious creation from that. Thankfully with lots of innovation and originality American brewers have taken this style to a new level. Whether it is highly hopping the brew or adding coffee or chocolate to complement the roasted flavors associated with this style. Some are even barrel aged in Bourbon or whiskey barrels. The hop bitterness range is quite wide but most are balanced. Many are just easy drinking session stouts as well.

American Pale Ale

Of British origin, this style is now popular worldwide and the use of local ingredients, or imported, produces variances in character from region to region. Generally, expect a good balance of malt and hops. Fruity esters and diacetyl can vary from none to moderate, and bitterness can range from lightly floral to pungent. American versions tend to be cleaner and hoppier, while British tend to be more malty, buttery, aromatic and balanced.

American Amber Ale

Primarily a catch all for any beer less than a Dark Ale in color, ranging from amber (duh) to deep red hues. This style of beer tends to focus on the malts, but hop character can range from low to high. Expect a balanced beer, with toasted malt characters and a light fruitiness in

most examples. The range can run from a basic ale, to American brewers who brew faux-Oktoberfest style beers that are actually ales instead of lagers.

Coconilla Porter

Inspired from the now wavering English Porter, the American Porter is the ingenuous creation from that. Thankfully with lots of innovation and originality American brewers have taken this style to a new level. Whether it is highly hopping the brew, using smoked malts, or adding coffee or chocolate to complement the burnt flavor associated with this style. Some are even barrel aged in Bourbon or whiskey barrels. The hop bitterness range is quite wide but most are balanced. Many are just easy drinking session porters as well.

Rye Pale Ale

Not to be confused with a German Roggenbier, beers that fall into this category contain a notable amount of rye grain in the grist bill. Bitterness tends to be moderate, to allow the often spicy and sour-like rye characteristics to pull through.

Scotch Ale

Scottish Ales traditionally go through a long boil in the kettle for a caramelization of the wort. This produces a deep copper to brown in colored brew and a higher level of unfermentable sugars which create a rich mouthfeel and malty flavors and aromas. Overall hop character is low, light floral or herbal, allowing its signature malt profile to be the highlight. Smoky characters are also common.

Munich Ale

When the golden and clean lagers of Pilsen (Bohemia) became all the rage in the mid-1800's, München brewers feared that Germans would start drinking the Czech beer vs. their own. Munich Helles Lager was their answer to meet the demand. A bit more malty, they often share the same spicy hop characters of Czech Pils, but are a bit more subdued and in balance with malts. "Helles" is German for "bright."

American Wheat

An Americanized version of a Hefe Weizen, these beers range within the pale to golden range in color. Reminiscent of a Hefe Weizen in appearance, unless filtered. Long-lasting head with a light to medium body, higher carbonation is proper. German Weizen flavors and aromas of banana esters and clove-like phenols will not be found. Most use a substantial percentage of wheat malt. Hop character will be low to high but most are moderate in bitterness. There may be some fruitiness from ale fermentation though most examples use of a fairly neutral ale yeast, resulting in a clean fermentation with little to no diacetyl.

The Troegenator Double Bock, is a dark, strong lager (8.2% abv). It pours into a glass with a bronze to brown color, fluffy white head and bready malt aroma. The Troegenator leaves a rich, warming feeling and subtle spicy flavors. The style, Double Bock, dates back a century or so ago. During periods of fasting without solid foods, the Monastic brewers relied on the double bock; a stronger, richer beer to fulfill their basic nutritional needs. Known to them as "liquid bread," a double bock has a strong malt aroma and chewy rich body. ABV: 8.2%
