Amending Chapter 262 of Millvale Borough Code – Stormwater Management, by implementing regulations for the management of stormwater; providing design standards; providing exemptions; providing a waiver process; prohibiting specified discharges; providing for enforcement; providing penalties; providing for stormwater management plans; providing for the establishment of fees; and providing definitions.
2. Adding Ordinance No. 2595 and establishing – Chapter 190 of the Millvale Borough Code by prohibiting specified noise-producing acts; providing exemptions; establishing a penalty for violations of the ordinance; and providing for the enforcement of the ordinance by the Borough of Millvale Police Department.
