North Hills Community Outreach provides grants, usually to non-traditional students, to further their education.

Grants depend on financial need and availability of funds.

Applicants must live or attend college or post-secondary trade school in northern Allegheny County north of the City of Pittsburgh and demonstrate financial need.

Applicants should be at 200% or lower of the federal income poverty guidelines.

Often, Education Assistance funds can be used for expenses related to attending any college or post-secondary school. Expenses can include tuition, fees, books and child care.
