



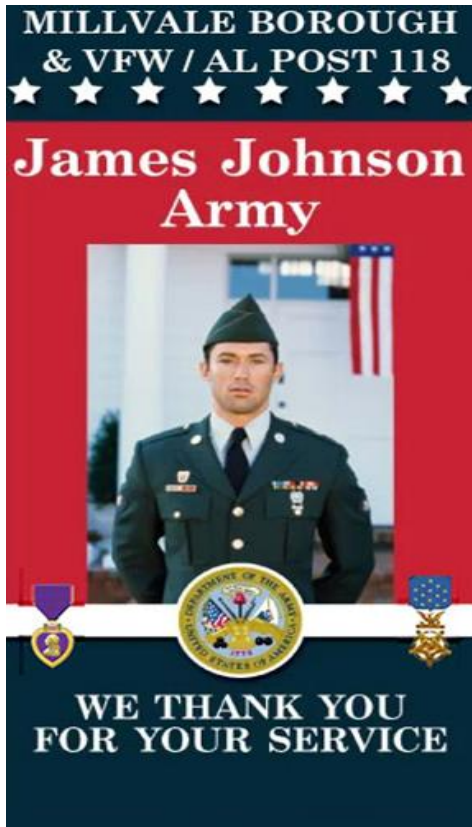
BOROUGH of MILLVALE & VFW/AL POST 118

These banners will be displayed in Millvale on Grant and North Avenues between Memorial Day and Veterans Day.

HONOREE QUALIFICATIONS

Eligibility requirements may change based on the number of applications received. We encourage all to apply.

The Honoree must currently serve or have served in the Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marines, including retired, honorably discharged, or killed in action.

The Honoree must be or have been a member of VFW / AL Post 118.

PROGRAM INCLUDES

One (1) 16"x 45" 18 oz. Tyvek Vinyl –Weatherproof full-color double-sided industrial banner.

The Pole Banner Bracket Hardware has been purchased through the Borough and donations.

Banner to be displayed for three years.*

The banner will be returned to the sponsor at the end of the three-year period.

REVIEW PROCESS

Millvale VFW/AL Post 118 will review each application, and it is at the sole discretion of the Borough and VFW/AL of approving or denying applications.

A set number of banners will be accepted each year.

BANNER PLACEMENT

The Borough determines banner placement, and Banner placement can vary from year to year.

Only banners purchased through this program will be displayed.

The expected life of the banner is three years, and after that period, you may reapply and purchase a new banner. If the banner becomes tattered, torn, or destroyed by (natural or unnatural events) within the three years, the Borough may choose to replace or remove the banner. *

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications can be found and are accepted online at www.millvalepa.com or inside the Millvale Borough Building. Applications must be complete. Incomplete applications will be returned.

Photos must be emailed to mjrevay@millvaleboro.com; no hard copy photos will be accepted. DO NOT send hard copy photos. The Borough will not be responsible for lost or damaged photos or returning the photo.

High-Resolution photo, black and white, or color of Honoree in uniform is preferred. Photo must be of the Honoree only. The sponsor is responsible for scanning all photos 150 dpi or more in a jpeg file, saved under Honoree's first and last name. Authorization of proofs required by the sponsor prior to printing banner.

Payment of \$90 will be requested after the application is approved. Do not include payment with the application.

Participation shall be granted on a first-come-first-serve basis.
